# A Dataset on the Socio-economic and Behavioural Impacts In Sri Lanka Through Multiple Waves of COVID-19


Outcome - A large 3020 household survey was conducted to ascertain the socioeconomic impact and human behaviour changes due to the pandemic and containment strategies covering all provinces of Sri Lanka. The ramifications on mobility, income, economic status, food consumption, education, access to health services and information, and cultural and psychological impacts were explored.

Impact - Enables the identification of underlying conditions that affected education, impact on society in terms of psychology, health and nutrition, and economic status.







Figure 3: Sample selection of the household survey in Sri Lanka
